Utah WSF Auction 2025

Utah Conservation Permit purchasers must pay the applicable resident or non-resident permit fee's when purchaser acquires the actual hunting license. Purchasers of Once-in-a-lifetime Conservation Permits will NOT be eligible to apply again in the regular UDWR public draw, as a Conservation Permit fulfills Utah's once-in-a-lifetime drawing opportunity. Additionally, Utah WSF will not act as a "go between" between the hunter and outfitter on any hunt sold that is not a conservation permit. The hunt buyer must work directly with the outfitter.
